I am requesting funding for the Airmont Water Storage Tank project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Round Hill, Virginia, located at 23 Main Street, Round Hill, VA 20141.

The funding would be used to construct and install an elevated water storage tank serving Round Hill. The funding is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will increase water storage capacity, reduce single-point-of-failure risks of the Town's existing, 60-year-old tank, and ensure access to clean drinking water for over 5,000 residents as well as local schools and businesses.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
