Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding for the Washington Dulles International Airport: Reconstruction of Taxilane D (Middle) and Taxilane F (West) project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority (MWAA), located at 1 Aviation Circle, Washington, DC 20001.

The funding would be used for a full-depth removal and replacement with new PCC pavement and base materials for Taxilane D Middle Section (Section D-02) and Taxiway F West Section (Section F-08) at Washington Dulles International Airport. The funding is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the pavement condition index for these taxilane sections is determined to be in the "poor" to "very poor" condition, a potential risk for creating debris that could require emergency repairs and result in unscheduled taxilane closures impacting the movement of aircraft and access to aircraft gates

This project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 49 U.S.C. 47100 et seq.
