I am requesting funding for the Lovettsville Transite Drinking Water Line Replacement project in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Lovettsville, Virginia, located at 6 East Pennsylvania Ave, Lovettsville, VA 20180.

The funding is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will replace approximately 2,800 linear feet of water lines that are constructed out of transite concrete, which contains asbestos and has proven health risks, with modern, generally accepted materials.

This project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
