I am requesting funding for the Route 15/Braddock Road Roundabout project in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Loudoun County, Virginia, located at 1 Harrison St SE, Leesburg, VA 20175.

The funding would be used for utility relocation and land acquisition for a project to design and construct a roundabout at the intersection of Route 15 (James Monroe Highway), Braddock Road (Route 705), and Old Carolina Road (Route 615). The funding is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will help mitigate safety issues, including a growing number of crashes due to inadequate sight distance on Braddock Road and the current lack of turn lanes on Route 15.
